REGULATION

- 3. Persons in sleeping sickness area to comply with directions of authorized officer
- 4. Penalty
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tsetse Fly Control Regulations. Citation
- 2. In these Regulations "authorized officer" means -

Interpretation

- (a) an administrative officer;
- (b) any member of the Botswana Police;
- (c) tsetse fly control officer; and
- (d) any member of the public service of Botswana carrying a written authority from the tsetse fly control officer authorizing him to act as an authorized officer for the purposes of these Regulations.
- 3. Any person travelling in any part of Botswana which the President Persons in has in terms of section 5 of the Act declared to be a sleeping sickness area sleeping shall comply with any directions given to him by an authorized officer sickness area requiring him --

to comply directions of authorized

officer

- (a) to travel by a specified route;
- (b) to pass through a specified de-flying chamber;
- (c) to cause the vehicles and animals in his custody to pass through a specified de-flying chamber;
- (d) to cause the vehicles and animals in his custody to pass through a specified cattle race;
- (e) to pass through a specified temporary picket; or
- (f) to cause the vehicles and animals in his custody to pass through a specified temporary picket.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of regulation 3 Penalty shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of R50 and to imprisonment for one month.
