This Act authorises the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of =N=4,493,363,957,158 (four trillion, four hundred and ninety-three billion, three hundred and sixty-three million, nine hundred and fifty-seven thousand, one hundred and fifty eight Naira) only, of which, =N=375,616,000,000 (three hundred and seventy-five billion, six hundred and sixteen million Naira) only, is for Statutory Transfers, =N=953,620,000,000 (nine hundred and fifty-three billion, six hundred and twenty million Naira) only, is for Debt Service, =N=2,607,132,491,708 (two trillion, six hundred and seven billion, one hundred and thirty-two million, four hundred and ninety-one thousand, seven hundred and eight Naira) only, is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the sum of =N=556,995,465,449 (five hundred and fifty-six billion, nine hundred and ninety-five million, four hundred and sixty-five thousand, four hundred and forty-nine Naira) inclusive of =N=144,420,000,000 (one hundred and forty-four billion, four hundred and twenty million Naira) Capital Expenditure in Statutory Transfers, is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2015.

# APPROPRIATION ACT, 2015

#### A Bill

### For

An Act to authorise the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of =N=4,493,363,957,158 (four trillion, four hundred and ninety-three billion, three hundred and sixty-three million, nine hundred and fifty-seven thousand, one hundred and fifty-eight Naira) only, of which, =N=375,616,000,000 (three hundred and seventy-five billion, six hundred and sixteen million Naira) only, is for statutory transfers, =N=953,620,000,000 (nine hundred and fifty-three billion, six hundred and twenty million Naira) only, is for debt service, =N=2,607,132,491,708 (two trillion, six hundred and seven billion, one hundred and thirty-two million, four hundred and ninety-one thousand, seven hundred and eight Naira) only, is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the sum of =N=556,995,465,449 (five hundred and fifty-six billion, nine hundred and ninety-five million, four hundred and sixty-five thousand, four hundred and forty-nine Naira) inclusive of =N=144,420,000,000 (one hundred and forty-four billion, four hundred and twenty million Naira) Capital Expenditure in Statutory Transfers, is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2015.

Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of -

1. (1) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall, when authorised to do so by warrants signed by the Minister charged with responsibility for finance, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation during the year ending on the 31st day of December 2015, the sums specified by the warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate =N=4,493,363,957,158 (four trillion, four hundred and ninety-three billion, three hundred and sixty-three million, nine hundred and fiftyseven thousand, one hundred and fifty-eight Naira) only.

Issue and appropriation from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for 2015.

(2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) of this section shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the First Schedule First Schedule to this Act.

(3) No part of the amount shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation after the end of the year mentioned in subsection (1) of this section.

Release of funds from the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

2. All amounts appropriated under this Act shall be released from the

Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation only for the purpose specified in the First Schedule to this Act.

First Schedule.

3. In the event that the implementation of any of the projects intended to be undertaken under this Act cannot be completed without virement, such virement shall only be effected with the prior approval of the National Assembly.

4. The detailed estimates of expenditure are set out in the Second Schedule to this Act.

5. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2015.
