# THE PLANT PROTECTION (DECLARATION AND CONTROL OF STRIGA) RULES

Citation

 These Rules may be cited as the Plant Protection (Declaration and Control of Striga) Rules, 2010.

#### Interpretation

2. In these Rules unless the context requires otherwise-

Cap. 133

"Act" means the Plant Protection Act;

"authorized officer" means agricultural officer, agricultural extension officer or any other administrative officer at the Local Government Authority; "inspector" means a Plant Protection Inspector appointed under section 33 of the Act:

"striga" means a plant of the family scrophulariaceae that is parasitic on the roots of the plants.

Declaration of striga

 Striga commonly called "witchweed" or "kiduha" is hereby declared to be a pest for the purposes of the Act.

Declaration of striga infested area

- 4.-(1) Areas listed in the Schedule to these Rules are hereby declared to be striga infested areas.
- (2) The Minister may by notice published in the Gazette amend the Schedule.

Duties of Inspector and authorized Officers in respect to the striga management 5. Where an inspector or an authorized officer has established that any land or plant is infested with striga, he may issue a notice that traditional measures be undertaken by the occupier or, in the absence of the occupier, the owner or a person having the charge or management of the land as he may deem fit. Obligation to report striga infestation

- 6.-(1) On receipt of a notice, signed by him directing the owner or occupier or a person having the charge or management of any land shall forthwith uproot and destroy the striga and all plants affected in accordance with the directions given by the inspector or authorized officer.
- (2) Where, following a direction by an inspector or an authorised officer no action or measures prescribed under these Rules is undertaken, the inspector or authorized officer shall undertake necessary measures, or order the measures be carried out in his presence, at the cost of the owner or occupier.
- (3) Any owner or occupier or a person having the charge or management of any land shall not move the striga from infested to non infested land.
- (4) For the purposes of controlling striga, the owner or occupier or a person having the charge or management of any land shall apply the following measures:
  - (a) hand pulling and hoe weeding for the prevention of striga production;
  - (b) use of striga free seeds for the prevention of new infestations;
  - (c) ensure early warning planting;
  - (d) undertake intercropping farming of cereals and legume;
  - (e) use of trap crops in rotation with cereals;
  - use of inorganic fertilizers and animal manures to suppress striga germination;
  - (g) use of host plant resistance;
  - (h) use of green manure;
  - use of tied ridges and mulch to delay striga emergence;
  - use of catch crops and appropriate herbicides as recommended by the agricultural Officers;
  - (k) use of crop rotation with non-host legumes; and
  - (I) use of Herbicides e.g. 2, 4D at a rate of 2 kg a 1/ha.

Offences and penalty 7. Any person who fails to comply with any direction issued by the inspector or an authorised officer pursuant to these Rules, commits an offence and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine of not less than two hundred thousand shilling or imprisonment for a term of not less than one month but not more than one year or to both such fine and imprisonment.
