An Act to amend the Property Transfer Tax Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Property Transfer Tax (Amendment) Act, 2002, and shall be read as one with the Property Transfer Tax Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Title and Commence-ment Cap. 340

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st April, 2002.

2. Section two of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1)-(a) by the deletion of the definition of "Commissioner"; and

(b) by the insertion in the appropriate place of the following new definition:

"Commissioner-General" means the Commissioner-General appointed under section nineteen of the Zambia Revenue Authority Act"

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section three and the substitution therefor of the following section:

Repeal and replacement of section 3

3. (1) The Commissioner General shall, subject to the direction of the Minister, be responsible for giving effect to the provisions of this Act, and shall for that purpose have all the powers conferred on the Commissioner-General by the Income Tax Act.

Power of General

(2) The Commissioner-General may, in writing and subject to such conditions as the Commissioner-General may specify, delegate to the Commissioner or to any officer in the Direct Taxes Division any power conferred, or any duty imposed, on the Commissioner-General by this section."

Amendment of section 5

4. Section *five* of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of the word "Commissioner" wherever it appears and the substitution therefor of the word "Commissioner-General"

Amendment of section 9

- 5. Section nine of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) in subsection (1) by the deletion of the word "Commissioner" and the substitution therefor of the word "Commissioner-General"; and
 - (b) in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) by the deletion of the word "Commissioner" and the substitution therefor of the word Commissioner-General; and
 - (c) in subsection (3) by the deletion of the word "Commissioner" and the substitution therefor of the word "Commissioner-General".
